

**AN ASSEMBLY** of the Principals and Electors of the Parish of St. Saviour was held at the Parish Hall on Thursday 4 July 2019 at 7.00pm for the following business:

- 1. Approve the minutes of the previous Parish Assembly held on Monday 20 May 2019.
- 2. Approve the minutes of a previous Parish Assembly held on Monday 3 September 2018.
- 3. To receive and, if approved, adopt the Connétable's Accounts for the financial year ended 30<sup>th</sup> April 2019;
- 4. To approve the Estimates for the financial year ending 30th April 2020;
- 5. To approve a Rate in conformity with Article 21 of the Rates (Jersey) Law, 2005;
- 6. To propose the transfer of the remaining funds from the EX Gratia Reserve to the Property Reserve Fund;
- 7. To elect a Committee to examine the Connétable's Accounts for the financial year ending 30<sup>th</sup> April 2020;
- 8. To appoint a firm of accountants to audit the Connétables Accounts for the financial year ending 30 April 2020.

The Connétable presided over an Assembly of 24 persons; apologies for absence were received on behalf of Mrs K Wyatt, Deputy L Doublet, Mr G Witts, T McDonald and Mr B De La Mare.

3. Connétable's Annual Accounts Year ended 30 April 2019

Mr Don Connelly of Alex Picot Accountants, took the Assembly through the accounts for the financial year ended 30th April 2019. Mr Connelly then asked for questions relating to year ended accounts 30 April 2019.

A Parishioner asked what the criteria was for issuing Charitable Grants. The Connétable explained that she issued a grant to those that requested one once she had sight of their accounts and was satisfied, they required funding.



The Connétable explained that the Parish funded The Bridge and Brighter Futures as they were in the Parish and was utilised by parishioners.

The parishioner then asked if the Connétable felt that £20,000 was the right level, she said yes it was as otherwise it could cause an increase in the rate. The parishioner asked if the parish policy would only be to issue grants to Jersey registered charities. The Connétable agreed that she would look into the legislation and would comply with it.

It was suggested that the heading be changed from Charitable Grants to Grants to Charities. The Connétable explained that it will consider the heading for next years accounts.

There being no further questions, the accounts were unanimously approved.

#### 4. Budget Estimates 2019 / 2020

The Executive Officer took the Assembly through the Budget Estimates for the financial year ending 30th April 2020. The EO then called for questions from the floor.

A Parishioner questioned why there had been such an increase in the Honorary Police estimate for 2019/2020. The EO explained that a member of staff whose work was predominately related to the honorary police was now being charged to the honorary police.

A further question was asked as to why the Parish gave £17,000 to Grands Vaux Youth Club. The Connétable explained that it was to fund a youth worker. The Parishioner asked if the youth worker was on the Parishes or the States payroll. The Connétable confirmed that he was a States employee, the Parishioner then asked why the Parish was funding a States worker. Deputy Macon explained that it was an historical agreement that to ensure there were enough youth workers available, the Parish and the States would co fund a youth worker.

There being no further questions the estimates, as detailed hereunder, were unanimously approved.

#### 5. Approval of Rate for 2019 / 2020

The Assembly was taken through the General Account and received an explanation of what effect the Island Wide Rate would have when combined with the Parish Rate. The Connétable informed the Assembly that the Accounts Committee recommended the Parish Rate should increase from 1.04p per quarter to 1.06p per quarter.

A Parishioner enquired if this was due to inflation. Procureur Mourant explained that it was not due to inflation but to increase the Parish reserves for unexpected expenditure that may arise.



The recommendation to set the rate at 1.06p per guarter was unanimously approved.

In closing, the Connétable thanked Mr Connolly (A Picot) for attending and all members of the Municipality, Associations, Committees and Clubs affiliated to the Parish who give freely of their time; also, the Staff at the Parish Hall and the Depot who provide support to all.

The Connétable then went on to discuss what challenges lay ahead for the Parish.



1) States Employment Board (SEB) and ongoing negotiations.

Year on year costs are rising and so are the salaries of our workforce. Around 60% of our rates income is spent on salaries with an expected increase of around 5% for both pay groups. The Connétable confirmed that the Parish cannot continue and encouraged for government to conclude the negotiations, any further delays could potentially could have a detrimental effect on our budgets but also on public workforce moral.

2) Climate change/recycling & government commitment to change and pressures to our parish infrastructure.

The Connétable commented that she would like to work towards to going green however echoed that more research is required at government level before the Parish decide to invest thousands on our infrastructure.

Procureur Peter Mourant concluded by announcing that this would be his final budget assembly as he would not be standing for re-election at the end of his term. He thanked the Connétable for her support and she in turn thanked him for all his hard work over the 30 plus years.

There being no further business the Connétable brought the meeting to a close at 8.00pm.
