**ITEM 1**

The minutes of the previous Parish Assembly held on 11 January 2021 were proposed by Martin Roberts, seconded by Deputy Kevin Lewis and unanimously agreed by the Assembly.



<b>ITEM 2</b>	<p>Mark Cox addressed the Assembly to explain that the new Co-op 5 Oaks store was being built to serve the existing local community who shop in the Five Oaks area. This store would be a similar size to that of their Grouville store approximately 5,000 sq ft. The store is due to open the middle of April 2022.</p> <p>The Connétable was pleased with the location of the new Co-Operative store as it was in a good location for residents in the area especially Les Cinq Chenes residents.</p> <p>Questions were asked whether the Maufant store would close. Mr Cox advised that there are currently no plans to close the Maufant store but this may be reviewed at a later date.</p> <p>On a proposition by Louise Ashworth, seconded by Katie A Sweeney, the Assembly unanimously agreed that a provisional 6th (Off-Licence) be granted.</p>
