ITEM 1	The minutes of the previous Parish Assembly held on 4 March 2024 were proposed by Deputy Ferey, seconded by Steven Laffoley-Edwards and unanimously agreed by the Assembly.



ITEM 2

Le Val Aumé footpath, also known as Swiss Valley has historical significance and has existed for hundreds of years, appearing on historical maps as far back as 1795. The path has been closed due to unsafe conditions mainly caused by water erosion. Thanks to funding from the Countryside Access and Wellbeing scheme the Parish plans to carry out the necessary works in order to reopen the path to the public.

The Connétable discussed a proposal to enter into a Contract of Arrangement with a neighbouring landowner in order to agree for the placement of new fences and rights for a new culvert drainage system to discharge rain waters from the path onto the land below. The Parish has enlisted the help of a GPS surveyor in order to record the location of the newly established fences which will assist in the future in maintaining the boundary even if the landscape changes over time. These items will be future proofed by the passing of a Contract of Arrangement before the Royal Court.

Connétable Lewis opened the floor for questions regarding the ongoing project, queries included:

- **Project Cost:** The total estimated cost is approximately £80,000, with £40,000 funded by a grant and the remaining £40,000 from the Parish Roads Account. It was confirmed that this figure includes a contingency.
- **Contractor Disruption:** Concerns were addressed about potential disruptions at the Beauvoir end of the project. It was clarified that most work would occur on the Eastern side, minimizing disruption.
- **Dog Bins:** It was confirmed that dog bin capacity at Les Varines end has been increased and additional bins will be installed at the opposite end.

Connétable Lewis provided responses and reassurances on these points.

The proposition as above was proposed by Deputy Ferey, seconded by Barry de la Mare 12 votes in favour none against.

ITEM 3

Connétable Lewis formally recognised the Long Service and Good Conduct Medals awarded to Honorary Police Officers Nigel Tanner, John Richards and Michael Byrne by His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor. He requested the Chef de Police to convey his appreciation to these Officers for their dedicated service.

Connétable Lewis thanked everyone for their attendance.

There being no further business the meeting was closed.
