ITEM 1	The minutes of the Parish Assembly held on 17 April 2025 were proposed by Steven Laffoley-Edwards and seconded by Steven Wyatt and approved by the Assembly.
ITEM 2	<p>Megan Buckley the Proposer addressed the Assembly to present an application on behalf of the applicant, Kenny Vieira, for the grant of a Sixth Category Liquor Licence for Supermarket Madeira located at 7 Bagatelle Road, St Saviour.</p> <p>During the discussion of the liquor licence application, the following questions were raised and responded to by the applicant and proposer:-</p> <p>Question: Will customers be permitted to stand outside the premises and consume alcohol? Answer: No, this will not be encouraged.</p>



	<p>Question: What are the proposed alcohol sales hours? Answer: Alcohol will be sold daily from 7 a.m. to 9 p.m., and on Sundays from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.</p> <p>Question: What is the reasoning for seeking an off-licence? Answer: The applicant explained that, after a few months of trading, a number of customers expressed a preference to purchase all their items, including alcohol, in one location. The Executive Officer noted that, from his understanding, the request to expand the product range was driven by customer demand.</p> <p>Question: Will all alcohol stock be stored on-site? Answer: A limited quantity will be kept on the premises, with the majority stored securely off-site. The Chef de Police requested to inspect the off-site storage facility for compliance. The Connétable advised that, under the Licensing Law, the Chef de Police is entitled to carry out inspections of the licenced premises and that the licence certificate must be clearly displayed on the premises.</p> <p>Question: Luciano Vieira on behalf of the applicant asked if a Sunday Trading Permit is required for the shop to trade on Sundays? Answer: The Executive Officer advised he would discuss this following the Assembly with the applicant.</p> <p>Question: Does the proposed manager have prior experience holding a liquor licence, and are they aware of the legal obligations? Answer: The proposer confirmed that while the proposed Manager has not previously held a liquor licence, they have retail experience and an understanding of the licensing requirements.</p> <p>On a proposition by the said Megan Buckley, seconded by Teresa Cassin and with the Connétable being satisfied that all of the required checks have been completed the Assembly agreed to recommend the application be granted.</p> <p>Connétable Lewis advised the applicant to appear before the Licensing Bench at the Royal Court on Thursday 16 June 2025 for the hearing of their application.</p>
