<b>CONVENING NOTICE:</b>	<p>The Executive Officer read the Convening Notice as follows:</p> <p>In accordance with Article 19 of the Elections (Jersey) Law 2002 a nomination Meeting will be held at St Saviour’s Parish Hall on Monday 13 November 2023 at 7.00 pm to: -</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Elect two Centeniers, each for a three-year term of office.</li></ul> <p>All Parishioners and electors of the Parish are welcome to attend.</p> <p>A nomination form for each candidate standing for election must be produced to the meeting and must be completed by a proposer and nine seconders who have registered and are on the electoral list in the parish. It is recommended that this be verified with the parish office beforehand.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• If there are more candidates than vacancies, an election shall be held on Wednesday 13 December 2023.</li><li>• If there are not more candidates than vacancies, the duly nominated candidates will be declared elected at the nomination meeting.</li></ul> <p>To vote in this election you must have registered by midday on Friday 10 November 2023.</p> <p>In accordance with Article 20, (8) of the Public Elections (Jersey) Law 2002, aforesaid, A nomination meeting shall not be closed less than 10 minutes after it has been opened.</p> <p>Parish Hall St. Saviour 6 November 2023</p> <p>Kevin C Lewis Connétable of St Saviour</p> <p>Parishioners are asked to arrive in good time in order to confirm their entitlement to vote.
