It is recommended that this be verified with the Parish office beforehand</p> <p>In each election:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• if there are more candidates than vacancies, a poll will be held on Wednesday 11 June 2025.• if there are not more candidates than vacancies, any duly nominated candidate will be declared elected at the nomination meeting.• To vote in this election you must have registered by midday on Thursday 8th May 2025 (article 12(c)). <p>In accordance with Article 20, (8) of the Public Elections (Jersey) Law 2002, aforesaid, a nomination meeting shall not be closed less than 10 minutes after it has been opened.</p> <p>Parishioners are asked to arrive in good time in order to confirm their entitlement to vote.
